POSITION AVAILABLE IN FOOD SAFETY-FOOD DEFENCE

Foreign Trade Service (FTS) specializes in the inspection, investigation and sampling of imported foods detained by the US Food and Drug Administration. These are specific foods imported from a certain countries, have a history of violations, and are subject to FDA detention or surveillance. FTS has a nationwide network of inspectors that have prior military and or prior law enforcement experience. The samples we collect and document are considered to be forensic samples for laboratory analysis and are used in the enforcement of federal law. Prior experience in the food industry is helpful but not necessary.

Job Title	Inspector-Sampler
Experience	Prior law enforcement, inspection or investigation experience is helpful. Prior experience with food inspection is not necessary.
Training	Persons with prior inspection, investigation or law enforcement experience will require a minimum of training. Training will be provided by FTS.
Requirements	Must be in good physical condition and computer literate with internet access. Must have a digital camera of 5 pixels or greater (absolutely no cell phone photos) and capable of uploading and forwarding photos by email.
Description of Duties	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The inspector makes an appointment for sampling at the designated warehouse (the importer will have released the product for sampling and inspection by FTS). The inspector will then go to the warehouse where the detained foods are being held in storage. 2. Identify the detained lot of imported food in the warehouse by lot number and warehouse receipts. Verify quantity to ensure entire lot is present. Check carton labeling and marks against description in documents submitted upon entry into the USA. 3. Document the detained lot by taking digital photos. 4. Collect and seal a prescribed number and portion of samples from each detained lot. 5. Label sampled product and corresponding samples 6. Complete an FTS Sample Collection Report form

	<p>7. Maintain chain of custody of samples; Seal, pack and ship samples to private lab via FedEx, UPS, DHL or another carrier (charges will be billed to a third party account).</p> <p>8. Forward digital photos via email to bud@ftslabs.com</p> <p>9. Forward original copy of Sample Collection Report and notes as directed</p> <p>10. Forward copies of shipment tracking numbers and warehouse receipts to FTS, Houston, TX.</p>
Food Products	All types of foods imported into the United States and detained by US FDA for prior history of non-compliance with FDA Regulations (Title 21 CFR and The Pure Food and Drug Act). These foods are subject to Detention Without Physical Examination. Foods included frozen and canned seafood; beverages, spices, ingredients, nuts, beans; fresh fruits and vegetables; rice and other grain; processed foods.
Locations Needed	Nationwide, but primarily near major ports of entry.
1099 Contractor Rate	\$35.00 per hour but not less than \$75.00 per sortie.
Expenses	Any extraordinary expenses related packing and shipping of samples will be reimbursed; airfare, hotel and other travel expenses when applicable; other unusual expenses or those agreed to in advance. Car expenses and mileage are covered in the hourly rate and are not additional.
Travel Option	We often have a need to send qualified persons to various locations around the United States. If you can travel, your airfare, hotel, meals, and rental car expenses are all covered by FTS.
